

Make your very own jetpack!



Materials:

- * 2-1 Liter bottles (clean and dry)
- * 1 inch wide elastic strips
- * silver duct tape
- * handful of fiber fill
- * red, orange or yellow tissue paper

* Cut the tissue paper into strips and sort into two "bunches."

* Cut elastic into two pieces, large enough to be used as shoulder straps.

* Fold each piece of elastic into a loop and tape each one onto a bottle.

* Tape both bottles together.

* Stuff some fiber fill into each bottle.

* Stuff one tissue paper "bunch" into each bottle opening, with most of the tissue paper coming out of the bottle as the flame. Tape around the bottle neck to hold the tissue paper in place.

Ideas for extra creativity:

* Decorate your jetpack with

paint, paper or stickers.

* Use crepe paper streamers or ribbon for the flames.

* Personalize your jetpack with your name or initials.

* Build a jetpack with things you can find around the house like empty cereal boxes, plastic cups, balloons and straws.
